



“Move Over Slow Drivers® (MOSD®)”
How It Works

1. A “Reporting Move Over Slow Driver” downloads the MOSD App into their smart phone.
2. The cell phone is placed in a car vent holder to capture slow blocking drivers in fast highway lanes.
3. When a MOSD reporting driver is behind a slow blocking vehicle in a fast highway lane, they activate the App by voice command. The App will beep for 30 seconds while it is recording.
4. The MOSD App records the license plate of the slow car, date, speed, GPS coordinates and the actual passing of the slow driver on his right (without his knowledge). The App then automatically forwards the data to the Clearinghouse.
5. The Clearinghouse reviews the video to see if there has been a violation.
6. If the Clearinghouse thinks there is a violation, the data will be automatically forwarded to Law Enforcement.
7. Law Enforcement will then decide how to proceed.
